



Chapter Global Community Building Award

PURPOSE

The Chapter Global Community Building Award recognizes chapters that have excelled in fostering a global community of nurses using learning, knowledge and professional development to improve the health of the world's people.

ELIGIBILITY

All active chapters of STTI are eligible for this award and are encouraged to apply.

NOMINATIONS

Any chapter member or officer may nominate. Self-nominations are invited.

CRITERIA

Chapter will be judged for the following qualities:

- Do chapter members collaborate with nurse leaders in other countries?
- Does the chapter create a global community that creates the broadest participation to bring diverse individuals together around a common focal point?
- Does the chapter create a global community of nurses using scholarship and leadership in innovative ways that promotes global networking and collaboration?
- Is the chapter open and accountable to its global stakeholders?
- Does the chapter facilitate and encourage an ongoing dialogue to ensure that their global communities remain relevant in a rapidly changing world?

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A complete nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- Supporting narrative that addresses criteria (1-2 pages)
- Three (3) letters of support from members, who are not currently serving on the chapter board, addressing how the chapter meets the criteria
- Letter of acceptance
