# Research Dissertation Award

### PURPOSE

The Research Dissertation Award recognizes a nurse whose doctoral dissertation is exceptionally meritorious and exemplifies high standards of scholarship and knowledge development. The recipient is required to have completed (defended) a dissertation between 1 January 2009 and 31 December 2010.

# **CRITERIA**

The dissertation:

- Has a study problem that is significant for the discipline of nursing.
- Proceeds from a clearly defined conceptual or theoretical base.
- Has methods (sample, data collection techniques and data analysis) that are valid and consistent with the research design.
- Contains findings that contribute to the body of nursing knowledge.
- Sets the stage for a research career and the direction for a program of research.

Note: Thesis or research projects for the Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) degree are not eligible for the Research Dissertation Award.

#### SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A copy of the completed dissertation will NOT be accepted for the entry.

A complete nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- A double-spaced summary (maximum of 15 pages), including in-text citations, of the dissertation without author identification.
- Three (3) letters of support (at least one from a dissertation committee member, preferably the chair) describing how the candidate's dissertation meets the award criteria.
- Letter of acceptance
- Signed signature page from the dissertation. Note: Please scan and upload the signature page through the online submission process. Hard copies will not be accepted.
