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PURPOSE

The Chapter Global Community Building Award recognizes chapters that have excelled in fostering a global community of nurses using learning, knowledge and professional development to improve the health of the world's people.

ELIGIBILITY

All active chapters of STTI are eligible for this award and are encouraged to apply. This award recognizes chapter activities from 1 March 2011 through 1 March 2013.

NOMINATIONS

Any chapter member or officer may nominate.

CRITERIA

- Collaborates with nurse leaders in other countries
- Creates a global community that creates the broadest participation to bring diverse individuals together around a common focal point
- Creates a global community of nurses using scholarship and leadership in innovative ways that promotes global networking and collaboration
- Is open and accountable to its global stakeholders
- Facilitates and encourage an ongoing dialogue to ensure that their global communities remain relevant in a rapidly changing world

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Supporting documents required below must address the criteria. A complete nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- Supporting narrative (1-2 pages)
- Three (3) letters of support from members, who are not currently serving on the chapter board, addressing how the chapter meets the criteria
- Letter of acceptance
