Evidence-Based Practice Award

In collaboration with the American Association of Critical-Care Nurses

PURPOSE

The Evidence-Based Practice Award is the process of integrating knowledge and clinical experience to achieve excellence in nursing practice. It is characterized by a high level of curiosity, critical thinking, continuous learning, reflective practice and the ability to seek and use a spectrum of interdisciplinary resources in care delivery.

The Evidence-Based Practice Award formerly known as the Clinical Scholarship Award was established in 1997 to recognize a nurse, group of nurses or organization who is self-motivated and foster a practice environment that promotes and values creativity, questioning, databased decision making, access and synthesis of new knowledge and the use of innovations to improve practice and clinical outcomes.

ELIGIBILITY

Current members of STTI's Board of Directors or members of the headquarters staff are NOT eligible.

CRITERIA

- Advances evidence-based practice through work in integrating knowledge and evidence in practice.
- Influences the health of individuals and communities by bringing together professionals from various disciplines and roles
- Engages researchers, clinicians, patience and families

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Supporting documents required below must address the criteria. A complete online nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- Supporting narrative (1-2 pages)
- Three (3) letters of support
- · Letter of acceptance
- Nominee's curriculum vitae
- Any other supporting documentation (not to exceed 10 pages)
