# Founders Awards Elizabeth McWilliams Miller Award for Excellence in Research

#### **PURPOSE**

The Founders Awards offer homage to the six founding nurses of STTI and the director of nursing at Indiana University for their insights in 1922 that advanced scholarship, leadership, research and practice. The awards recognize extraordinary excellence.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Nominee must be an active member of Sigma Theta Tau International. Current members of STTI's Board of Directors or members of the headquarters staff are NOT eligible.

### **NOMINATIONS**

Two active members or a chapter are required to nominate an individual.

### **CRITERIA**

- · Conducts distinguished research in nursing
  - o Provides evidence of published and unpublished research
  - Submits evidence of reviews and/or critiques of research by acknowledged experts
  - Provides documentation of use of nominee's research and/or scholarly works in nursing education, practice and/or research
- · Communicates nursing research findings
  - o Publications
  - o Conferences/workshops/seminars
  - Consultations
  - Teaching
- Writes scholarly works related to nursing theory and/or nursing research
- · Gives evidence of a history of nursing research activities
  - o Conducts research over time
  - o Collaborates with other researchers
  - o Facilitates nursing research efforts of others
  - o Conducts or assists in research conferences/workshops
  - Serves as editor and/or serves on advisory/editorial panels of research journals
  - Participates in review of research proposals (local, state, national or global)

### SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Supporting documents required below must address the criteria. A complete online nomination consists of:

- · Online entry form and payment
- Supporting narrative (1-2 pages)
- Three (3) letters of support from national and global leaders internal and external to nursing
- Nominee's curriculum vitae
- · Letter of acceptance
