



Research Dissemination Award

PURPOSE

The Research Dissemination Award recognizes an individual or group who has made a major contribution to the dissemination of research for use in clinical nursing practice, education, administration, research and/or public knowledge.

Dissemination of research findings refers to a systematic effort or project that is directed toward making the essentials of completed research available to nurses or to the public in an accessible and usable format.

ELIGIBILITY

Current members of STTI's Board of Directors or members of the headquarters staff are NOT eligible.

CRITERIA

The project or program:

- Has the primary purpose of imparting new nursing research knowledge to nurses and/or the non-nursing community.
- Contains scientific merit and synthesis of existing research as an essential component.
- Has been made available in a convenient manner and at a reasonable cost and is presented in a form that is helpful and useful. Examples include: television or radio talk shows; public service announcements or programs; newspapers, magazines or books; video or audio tapes; meetings or conferences; promotional campaigns.
- Is packaged in a manner that will attract attention and provide information to benefit nurses and the non-nursing community.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Supporting documents required below must address the criteria. A complete online nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- Supporting narrative (1-2 pages)
- Three (3) letters of support
- Sample of final product (scanned newspaper articles, video clip, etc.), if applicable
- Letter of acceptance
