Education Technology Award

PURPOSE

The Education Technology Award recognizes and honors an individual that clearly exemplifies an outstanding instructional use of technology for one of the following:

- · Nursing students
- Professional nursing distance learning and continuing education
- General public

Pilot projects accepted; please include completion timeline and remaining operation milestones for completion.

CRITERIA

Criteria could relate to the use or development of an educational technology application and should be addressed accordingly.

- Uses technology in a manner that furthers professional goals, purposes, concerns and issues such as leadership, scholarship, research, image, humanity, thinking, decision making or problem solving.
- Enhances, supports or mimics the scientific, humanitarian and intellectual pursuits
 of the nursing profession and is operational in generating outcomes or products
 that are of benefit to nursing as a profession or to the health of the public.
- Describes the development of the process and procedure.
- Bug free (e.g., all items work); is easy to navigate. If it requires installation, it
 installs and uninstalls easily. If on the Web, it is easily located.
- Describes how the technology is instructionally sound, logically organized and motivating.
- Identifies skill level and any prerequisites needed by the audience
- Content and approach are appropriate and of value for the intended audience.
- Easy to use and has appropriate instructions for use including context sensitive help when necessary.
- Is innovative, interactive, creative, flexible and uses technology well.
- Has had significant leadership and involvement of nurses throughout the development of the application including design, selection, development, implementation and evaluation.
- List costs of development and source(s) of funding.
- Describe any noteworthy aspects that the committee should know that are not delineated above including, but not limited to, how this program/website has value beyond one institution and how it furthers the mission and vision of STTI.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Supporting documents required below must address the criteria. A complete online nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- Supporting narrative (1-2 pages)
- Letter of acceptance
- Any supporting software or URL, Provide passwords and allow usage through judging process (March-May)
- Any other supporting documentation (not to exceed 10 pages) might include, but is not limited to
 - Screen shots
 - o Articles about the application
 - Testimonials
