## PURPOSE

The purpose of the Honor Society of Nursing, Sigma Theta Tau International (STTI) Nurse Researcher Hall of Fame is to recognize nurse researchers who are STTI members who have achieved long term, broad national and/or international recognition for their work and whose research has impacted the profession and the people it serves.

## ELIGIBILITY

All active STTI members are eligible. Members of the headquarters staff, board of directors and members of the judging committee are not eligible

## CRITERIA

- Demonstrated long-term impact of the nurse researcher and his/her funded program of research on patient/family outcomes, community wellness and/or health care policy nationally and/or internationally
- Influence of the nurse researcher as a mentor and role model for students, faculty and practicing nurses
- Recognition as a scholar and leader in research nationally and/or internationally

## SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A complete nomination consists of:

- Online entry form and payment
- Supporting narrative that addresses criteria (not to exceed two pages)
- Three (3) letters of support that address criteria
- Nominee's curriculum vitae, plus a listing of 10 most relevant publications, including nursing and non-nursing peer reviewed publications
- Letter from the nominee agreeing to be nominated and attend research congress if selected
- Supporting documentation that provides evidence of nominee's contribution as outlined in criteria (not to exceed 10 pages) Use the following subheadings:
  1. Demonstrated long-term impact of the nurse researcher and his/her funded program of research on patient/family outcomes, community wellness and/or health care policy nationally and/or internationally;
  2. Influence of the nurse researcher as a mentor and role model for students, faculty and practicing nurses;
  3. Recognition as a scholar and leader in research nationally and/or internationally. Reference the supporting documents as demonstration of impact.
